- Prospective Organization will work closely with its members to elicit their interest for joining MMH.

And, therefore in order to establish the above, the Participants agree to cooperate in the following areas:

1. Exchange of Information where applicable, like Print and Electronic Media, Internet, Web site.
2. Identifying prospective clients for MMH and making the necessary introductions.

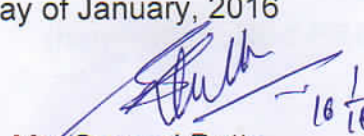
3. Facilitating the meeting and agreements with prospective clients, promoting joint ventures, investments, and strategic alliances for promotion of MMH.

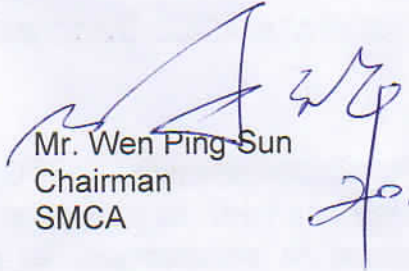
